



## A. ACADEMIC MATTERS

### 1. Sensitization Seminar on Educational Opportunities in the European Union (EU)

The Centre for European Studies, University of Ghana in collaboration with the European Union (EU), on 11 November 2016, organised an information session to sensitize students on the educational opportunities available to them within the European Union, especially the Erasmus Mundus Programme. The Director of the Centre for European Studies, Professor Ransford Gyampo, and the Head of the European Union in Ghana, Ambassador William Hanna, as well as other EU officials and Erasmus Mundus alumni took turns to inform the students about the educational programme and the various avenues and opportunities available to them. The educational and sensitization seminar was targeted at students who want to undertake internships and further education in Europe.

### 2. Interaction with the Graduate School

## C. FUND RAISING

#### Visit by the Andrew Mellon Foundation

A delegation of the Andrew Mellon Foundation made up of the Executive Vice President of the Foundation, Prof. Mariet Westermann, and the International Higher Education and Strategic Projects Director, Dr Saleem Badat, paid a three-day working visit to the University between October 3-7, 2016. The team held meetings with the Vice-Chancellor, Pro Vice-Chancellor (ASA), the Provost College of Humanities, and the Directors of Finance, Public Affairs and Institutional Research and Planning Office. A workshop was organised for the Delegation attended by Deans and Directors and graduate students from the College of Humanities. The team also met with officials of the National Council for Tertiary Education and the Ministry of Education. At a debriefing session at the end of their visit, the delegation expressed interest in University of Ghana submitting an application for funding to support the Humanities.





## D. CONFERENCES/WORKSHOPS AND LECTURES

### 1. College of Humanities 2<sup>ND</sup> Dialogue Series

The College of Humanities (CoH) on October 13, 2016, held the second in the series of its Dialogues, which saw three Asian ambassadors speaking on the on the theme "Africa-Asia Relations: The Search for New Frontiers". Her Excellency (H.E.) Ms. Sun Baohong, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the People's Republic of China to Ghana, spoke on the theme 'China-Africa Cooperation: a model of Asia-Africa relations. H. E. Kaoru Yoshimura, Japanese Ambassador to Ghana, focused on the 60 years of good relations between Ghana and Japan, recounting historically important events that have occurred at roughly the same time in each country. H. E. Lyeo-Woon Ki, South Korean Ambassador to Ghana stressed on Africa.

## 2. Launch of ISSER'S State of The Ghanaian Economy Report, 2015

The Vice Chancellor, Professor Ebenezer Oduro Owusu performed the launch of the 25<sup>th</sup> edition flagship report of the Institute of Statistical, Social and Economic Research (ISSER): The State of the Ghanaian Economy Report (SGER) 2015. The Vice-Chancellor in his closing remarks, commended ISSER for the painstaking research in coming up with the Report. He said ISSER's role in providing empirical-based knowledge on the economy and the neutral stance of the report, he hoped will set the agenda in the media space for meaningful discussion towards national development.
