



A. ACADEMIC MATTERS

1. STRENGTHENING POSTGRADUATE EDUCATION AND SCHOLARSHIP IN THE HUMANITIES

- i. The University of Ghana has been granted an amount of \$800,000 (eight hundred thousand US dollars) by the Andrew Mellon Foundation to enhance capacity and postgraduate education in the humanities. The first cohort of PhD and MPhil students started their postgraduate education in the 2017/2018 academic year.
- ii. The German Ministry has approved a proposal to build a "Merian Centre" at the University of Ghana. The proposal was developed by a consortium of universities led by the University of Freiburg and including the University of Ghana. The aim is to establish a Centre for Advanced Studies at the University of Ghana with a secondary site in Dakar, Senegal.

B. PUBLICATIONS

A book project on Multidisciplinary Perspectives on Transformation in Africa, a productof the first College of Humanities International Research Conference, and edited by Peter Quartey, Samuel Agyei-Mensah, Samuel NiiArdeyCodjoe and Basit Aziz Bamba has been published by Sub-Saharan African Publishers and will be launched soon. The book brings together research of young and established academics from within and outside the country, to analyze and further interrogate the challenges facing the continent and propose new ways of dealing with such complex issues using multidisciplinary approaches.

C. PARTNERSHIPS

The College and the University have forged new institutional partnerships to promote research, exchange of students and faculty. These partnerships include:

- University of Ghana and the School of Political Science and Public Administration of University of Electronic Science and Technology of China (UESTC). The partnership is to promote exchange of students, faculty, and the hosting of conferences.
- University of Ghana and Albert-Ludwigs-University Freiburg, Germany have signed an MOU to establish an International Centre for Advanced Studies on Sustainable Governance at the University of Ghana. New partnership agreements have also been forged with the following Mexican Universities.
 - ITESO (Universidad Jesuita de Guadalajara)
 - Universidad del Valle de Atemajac (UNIVA)





D. CREATING A SPACE FOR SCHOLARLY DEBATES AND LECTURES

The College and its constituent units have been very vibrant in the organization of research conferences, lectures, symposia and workshops. These include the College of Humanities International Research Conference and the College of Humanities Dialogue Series. The University and the College in November 2017 cohosted the International Conference on Public Administration in collaboration with University of Electronic Science and Technology of China, Ghana Institute of Management and Public Administration (GIMPA) and the University of Cape Coast. The conference brought together participants from a number of countries including China, Ethiopia, Ghana, India, Indonesia, Lesotho, Japan, Macao, Netherlands, Nigeria, South Africa, South Korea and the United States.
