- b). Competence in any two of the following: Ancient Greek or Roman History, Ancient Greek or Roman Philosophy, and Ancient Greek or Roman Literature.
- c). Ability to conduct scholarly research at the highest level and attract a funded research programme.
- d). Show promise in research as demonstrated by publications and conference. presentations, as well as strong endorsement by referees.
